WHAT INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

In running our business at Magical & Messy, we may collect and process the following data about you when you access, purchase, or subscribe to services: -

Information provided by you, for example, personal details when you register for information or make a purchase.

We only collect basic personal data about you which does not include any special types of information or location-based information.

HOW WE COLLECT YOUR DATA

We collect data from you in the following ways: -

- Data that is collected by website cookies (please refer to cookies section for further details on this data collection)

DATA THAT IS COLLECTED AUTOMATICALLY

HOW DO WE USE YOUR DATA?

We use the personal data you provide us with to provide you the service, product, update, or news which you have signed up. We use this data in accordance with this data privacy policy.

We will not collect data that we do not need to provide and oversee to what you have signed up for.

When you have signed up to services, product, updates, or news we would like to use your data in the future to inform you of similar products and to inform you of any changes to our business, website, services or goods and products.

This information is not shared with third parties and you can unsubscribe at any time via phone and email.

We never give your details to third parties.

HOW DO WE STORE YOUR DATA?

Your data is stored on secure servers. All internal administrative records kept for business purposes when you request services from us are stored on password protected devices.

HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR DATA FOR?

We are required under UK law to keep your basis personal data (name, address, contact details) for a minimum of 6 years after which time it will be destroyed.

Your information we use for marketing purposes will be kept with us until you notify us that you no longer wish to receive this information.

WHAT PAYMENT DETAILS DO WE STORE?

We do not store credit card details, nor do we share customer details with any 3rd parties.

YOUR RIGHTS

Your right as outlined in the Data Protection Act 2018 are as follows: -

Right to access - You have right to access your data held by us and to access this for free of charge.

Right to correct - If you believe data, we hold on you is inaccurate you can request for this to be corrected or deleted.

Right to erase- You have the right to request we erase your data held by us.

Right to restrict our use of your data - You have the right to block or restrict the way we use your data.

Right to data portability – You have the right to request that we move, copy, or transfer your data.

Right to object – You have the right to object to the way in which we use your data.
